The New Life Orphanage cares for babies from birth to 3 years of age. Jaye wanted to take some supplies for the children and JFM

had children's medications left from our August 2016 medical camp to donate. It was wonderful to see the great care these infants and toddlers were receiving. We held the babies and played with the toddlers.

As we were preparing to leave, there was a sudden bustle of excitement as all the caregivers came to the lobby. We were told one of the babies was being adopted and the new mother had come to receive her baby. We sang a joyous song together, "This Is The Day That The Lord Has Made" then, "This Is The Child That The Lord Has Made" then, "This Is The Mother..." then, "This Is The Family...". Jaye prayed for them then we watched that new mother hold her baby close, put him on her back and tie him to herself with blankets. As she left with her new adopted child you could see the love and happiness on her face.
