#### APPLICATION FOR EDUCATION AND DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

The Colonel John Haynes Trust supports current and former members of the Royal Australian Armoured Corps (RAAC) and their immediate family through provision of welfare assistance.

Financial grants for Education, Support and Development funds are awarded annually. Applications may be made during the period commencing on 1 July and will close on 30 October each year. The Trust will assess the applications and advise applicants by 20 November with the aim to provide funds by early in December for use in the following calendar year.

Note: Application for Immediate Welfare can be made at any time using the Application for Welfare Support Funds available at the Haynes Trust website.

Applications may be made directly by the applicant or on behalf of a beneficiary.

To be eligible, a beneficiary must meet one of the following criteria and be able to provide supporting evidence:

- Is a serving or ex-serving member of the Royal Australian Armoured Corps, whether Regular, Reserve or National Service members of the Corps; or
- Is an immediate family member of a serving or ex-serving member to two generations (eg: spouse, widow/widower, child/ step-child and grand-children)

An application must include contact details of a referee nominated by the applicant who is required to provide a declaration regarding the information provided.

In addition, applicants are required to provide details of any government financial assistance and any funding or support provided by other entities. The application must also include specific details of the expense for which funding will be used.

Funding may be awarded for education and course related expenses other than the payment of HECS-HELP fees/debts as well as other activities which enable the development or support for individuals or groups of eligible beneficiaries.

Where an application is successful and a grant has been provided to the beneficiary, there is a requirement to provide evidence that the funds have been used for the intended purpose.

When completing the form, \* denotes mandatory fields which must be filled.
