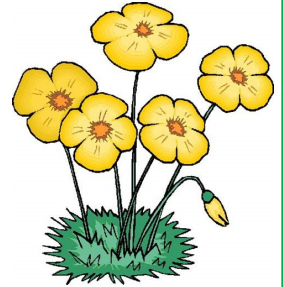

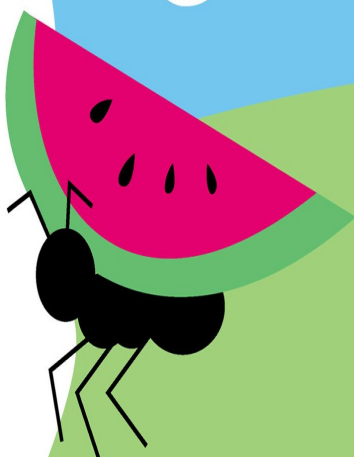

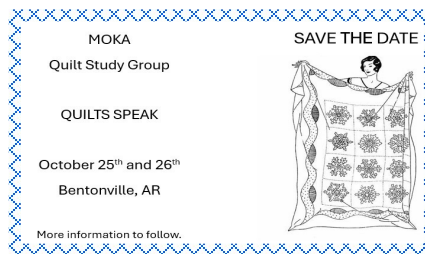


**There will be a Quilt of Valor Presentation on Saturday, June 1 at 2 pm at St. Theodore's Episcopal Church. Friends and family of veterans receiving quilts and Calico Cut-Ups members are welcomed to attend.**



On Monday, June 24th nationally recognized quilter, Timna Tarr will present her **Flying Colors** trunk show. Timna is known for making fun, colorful, award winning quilts. Timna will share her quilting journey as she talks about her design and color choices, as well as the personal stories behind the quilts.

Timna comes from a long line of quilters but did not begin quilting until after studying art history in college. She bought her first longarm in 2001 and began quilting clients' quilts shortly thereafter. Timna's nationally award winning quilts are in private and corporate collections and have been seen in exhibits, publications, and on The Quilt Show and Quilting Arts TV. Timna is a designer for Studio e Fabrics, the author of *Stitched Photo Mosaic Quilting*, and is an in-demand teacher and speaker. Timna lives in South Hadley, Massachusetts and will be speaking to our guild and two others in Northwest Arkansas while she is in the area.



**MOKA (Missouri, Oklahoma, Kansas, Arkansas) Quilt Study Group** is a regional quilt study group open to anyone interested in the study of quilts, quilt history, quilt patterns and quiltmakers, past and present. MOKA Quilt Study Group meetings are held two times a year at a location in one of the four states they represent.

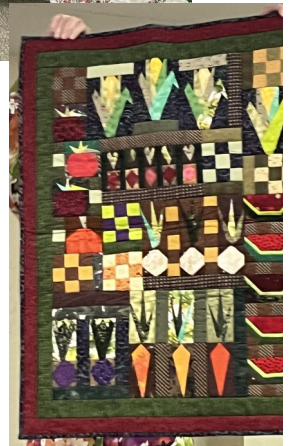
