DAVID AND TERESA DUWE

Our **July 29th** speakers are David and Teresa Duwe, from Overland Park, Kansas. The title of their trunk show is: **What's Old Is New Again** and will show a collection of over 40 quilts recreated and reborn using newer techniques, many with old linens.

David is self-taught and began quilting in the early 1990's. He loved woodworking and thought of the sewing machine as just another



tool he could use. Teresa became interested in quilting after a trip to the Houston International Quilt show in 2005 and David became her first teacher. David is a traditional piecer and Teresa leans toward more modern techniques. They have had quilts displayed in Houston and Paducah, and have won various ribbons including Best of Show at the Kansas State Fair.

BARBARA J. EIKMEIER



On August 26th, our speaker will be Barbara J. Elkmeier from Lansing, Kansas. Barbara learned to sew in 4-H and made her first quilt while in high school but didn't start quilting seriously until after she was married in 1984. Quilting became a portable career as they moved around the country and to South Korea with the military. Barbara has written four quilting books, is a pattern and fabric designer and an instructor on Craftsy. The title of her trunk show is: *Just Solids*. Historically, solids appeared in appliqued quilts, Amish quilts, 1930's quilts, and Hawiian quilts. Today solids are commonly seen in modern quilts. This show has something for everyone as Barbara shares her love of solids. Barbara will be retiring from teaching in November. We are excited to have her join us one last time.

PORTRAIT QUILT WORKSHOP

Our very own, Linda Crandell will be offering a workshop teaching how to design and construct a portrait quilt. Attendees may select from 2 images or provide Linda with a picture of their own pet for this project. The personal pet pictures must be submitted no later than JULY 31st. The photograph must be a good quality and resolution. The workshop cost is \$45 and will be from 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. on August 27th.


4th Annual Quilt Auction!
