### Supply List:

Embroidery Hoop 12 inches or larger  
2 squares of fabric, about 18"x18" (solid color best, may be plain muslin)  
1 square cotton batting the same size as the fabric  
Thread (does not have to be hand quilting thread, and colored thread is easier to see)  
Thimble to fit middle finger (any kind)  
Scissors

## **Cut Time! Quilt More!**

Our March presentation is "Cut Time! Quilt More!" provided by Quilt Sampler quilt shop from Springfield, MO. As we all know, perfect points and crisp lines in our final quilts begin with accurate cutting. In this lecture/demonstration, Shannon Wright and Cristen Jones will walk us through the advantages of using *Accuquilt* to cut down on time and increase accuracy in our cutting. We will also delve into proper use of the machine to get the best cut with the least amount of waste. In this lecture/demo, doors will open and lights will shine with the excitement of what can be done.
