### Quilts by Jan Williams

She has finished up 3 English Paper -pieced quilts during the pandemic. Some of you will remember her demos at our guild meeting.

This one is a 3/4inch hexagon queen size top that she will be hand quilting. This quilt is 112"x 94". It has 9,000 hexies in it.

This quilt is from the book "The New Hexagon" by Katja Marek. The hexagons are 6" on each side. Jan used mostly Kaffe Fassett fabric for some of the hexagons and fussy cut large flowers from some of the fabric instead of paper -piecing them.



This quilt by Jan came from a pattern by Lucy Carson Kingwell called Smitten. It is made of 9" English paper-pieced hexagons. Some of the large hexagons are made of smaller paper-pieced hexagons.

This Quilt is a wedding gift that is going in the mail soon.
