Why is God worthy of so much trust? His character is above reproach, his love is unconditional, his power and knowledge are unmatched, his promises are sure, his presence is inescapable, and his guidance is always in our best interest. And if that isn’t enough, then God’s track record defies human logic. God always speaks truth. Always loves. Always provides. Is there anyone else in your life who deserves your trust any more than God?




*For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time for us to do.*




