- The Dreaming Tree Project Penny just set up the Dreaming Tree Project in 2017 and she wanted money to help buy radio aids for deaf children.

It was a good mix of pitchers and a very difficult choice for some, but in the end the money went to Penny and the Dreaming Tree Project. She said it would go straight to buying a radio aid for a deaf little boy who really needs it and she will be back in July to let us know how it went.
