- Shanklin Youth Club This youth club is run by Surrey Clubs for Young People (SCYP). Joyce from SCYP told us all about the fantastic work they do and pitched for funds to help them keep doing it. She also asked for volunteers as they are in desperate need.
- Carshalton Community Allotment This community allotment scheme is run by EcoLocal. Tansy from EcoLocal pitched and told us all about the therapeutic gardening sessions they provide for local people who have mental health problems and learning difficulties.



In the end, the money went to Free Cakes for Kids by a considerable margin – Lynne and Abigail, who was there for support, were thrilled to bits to receive their cheque. £560 will keep them in cakes for quite a while! They will of course be coming back to see us in January and give us an update.
