If you did not receive an invoice, please let me now.

REMINDER: <u>Annually on or about July 1^{st,} an invoice will be sent to each Detachment/Unit/Pack and Pound for the annual dues.</u>

We are continuing to update the email address list for those who wish to receive the Illinois Marine via email. If you are receiving this publication via hardcopy and have email, please consider requesting it by email. Each hardcopy mailed out costs the Department on average 85 to 95 cents. Any reduction of postage expenses benefits the Department of Illinois's budget. 




The Marines' Prayer
