REMINDER: <u>Annually on or about July 1^{st.} an invoice will be sent to each Detachment/Unit/Pack and Pound for the annual dues.</u>

If you are receiving this publication via hardcopy and have email, please consider requesting it by email. Each hardcopy mailed out costs the Department on average 85 to 95 cents. Any reduction of postage expenses benefits

Please let me know if that is the case. I would ask that a list of all "New" members with Name, Address and email, if available, be submitted to the editor to facilitate addition to the mailing or email list.





