## Butterfly class home activities



As you go through the story, encourage your child to count the fruit with you. Can they remember how many apples he ate on Monday? See if they can tell you how many plums he ate on Wednesday and how many oranges he ate on Friday?

As you count these, encourage your child to show you the corresponding amount of fingers for each number.



Write the digits 1 - 5 on a piece of paper and see if your child can identify the correct number as you talk about the number of fruits.

Choosing different items from the story, play a clapping game to identify the syllables in the words, for example 'straw - be - rry' ( 3 claps) or 'a - pple' ( 2 claps)
