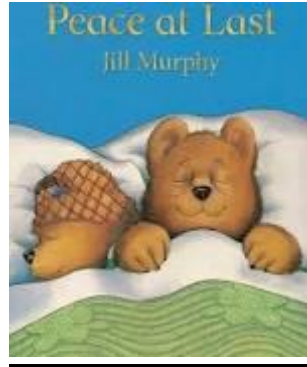


Butterfly class home activities

Once you have watched the story discuss the following with your child:



- Why couldn't Mr Bear get to sleep?
- What was Baby Bear pretending to be in his bedroom?
- What noise could Mr Bear hear in the living room?
- Which animals were making noises in the garden?

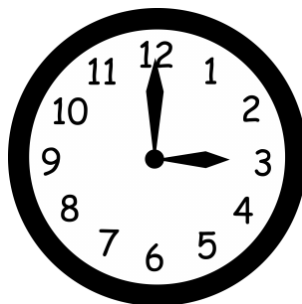
Go for a walk around the house with your child. Shhhh....Be really quiet....What noises can you hear?



Encourage your child to make the noises they can hear using their own voices. Can they make these using loud voices, quiet whispers, scary voices etc?

Encourage your child to draw a picture of their own bear or a favourite toy. (Don't forget to email this to us)

See if your child can independently count these clocks.





Can they point to the correct number?


Practise 'sssss' with your child. What can you find in your home that begins with this sound?
