
Butterfly class home activities

Can your child identify the pictures below and choose the two that sound the same?










Go for a walk around your home and see if you can identify any other things that sound the same.

This week we would also like you to explore the letter t. Have a look at the link below to see how we pronounce the sounds.

Practise the 't' sound with your child . Can they point to the pictures that begin with 't'?







See if your child can think of something beginning with t and have a go at drawing it. Don't forget to email your picture to us!

Look at our letter formtation sheet and see how form the letter t. Support your child to form a large letter t in the air with your finger.



Now see if your child can form the letter in different ways, you could try this on a plate covered in flour, in a tray of rice or with a pen or pencil on paper. Don't forget to take a photo and send it to us.



When your child has learnt the 't' sound see if they can remember 's' and 'a' from previous weeks.

In the story this week the frog sat on a log. Have a go at placing your child's favourite toy on a chair. See if they can tell you the position of the toy. Then change position, perhaps under or beside the chair and see if they can tell you the position. Let your child sit on, under or beside the chair and see if they can describe their

position to you. Maybe you could take pictures of them and send it to us with their descriptions?
