


## Ladybird Class home activities


Can your child make the animal noises? Do they know the names of the animals? Can they tell you what animal they would like as a pet?

Can they remember any of the animals from the book if you ask them? You could read the book again and ask your child which animal comes next to help them.

Can your child do any actions like some of the animals? Can they jump like a frog, or slither like a snake?



Can your child tell you which animal is the biggest, or tallest, or smallest from the story? Can they find a big toy and a small toy?



Can they find any toy animals, or other books at home that have got some of the same animals in?

Can they build one of the animals with building blocks? Or make one of the animals from some of your clean recycling? Or can they paint some of the animal patterns?
