
Ladybird Class home activities

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Talk with your child about how important it is to help other people. Link it to the story whereby sometimes, if you help someone when you don't really want to, there might be treat as a reward. See if you can get your child to help you with some cooking or cleaning or tidying.





Have a go at baking some bread or making some cakes together.
