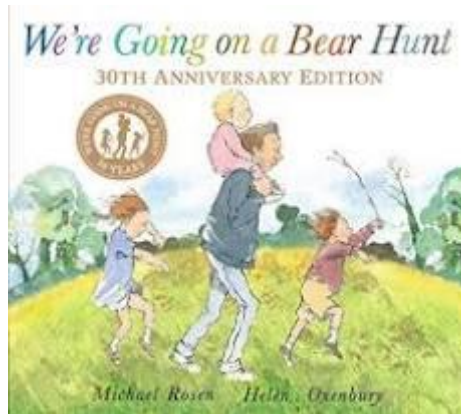


Ladybird Class home activities



The story for this week is *We're Going on a Bear Hunt*.

Read the story together if you have the book at home, or you can find it using the following link.

Can your child copy/make the noises from the story? What about act out getting stuck in the mud, or tripping over some tree roots!

Can they remember any of the different places the family went on their adventure? Have they been to a forest before, or splashed through water or squelched in mud? If you have any old photos of you and your child doing these, show them to remind them.



When you go out on one of your daily exercise walks, can you spot any teddy bears in the windows? Maybe you could put one of your bears in the window to wave at people walking by.

Can they have a teddy bears picnic one lunch time with their toys. Share out some plates with members of the family and some toys and then share out some food - pretend food or real food if you can!



Can you make a texture story board, using different things from around the house. Maybe collect some real grass from outside on one of your daily walks, use a bottle of water to splash, make some trees from soft material, use cotton wool for the snow storm.
