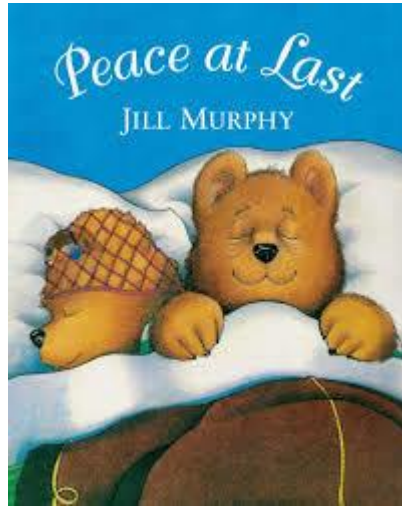


Ladybird Class home activities



The story for this week is Peace at Last.

Can your child copy/make the noises from the story?
Can you take some photos of your child pretending to be Mr Bear trying to sleep in different parts of your house?



Can you go on a sound hunt around the house? What kinds of sounds can you hear? The tick tock of a clock, the hum of the fridge/freezer, the birds tweeting outside, the rustling of leaves on the trees, cars vrooming by?



Can your child remember and name the item that kept Mr Bear awake when you make the sound?

Can your child think of a good song they could sing Mr Bear to help him get to sleep? Talk about what their bedtime routine is.



On one of your daily walks, can your child find a shadow? A shadow of something big and a shadow of something small? Can they make their shadow disappear? Can they catch your shadow?

Can your child practise putting their own pyjamas on tonight? Can they choose their favourite set and put them on all by themselves? Grown-ups, don't worry if they're mismatching or back-to-front; just be proud of what they manage!
