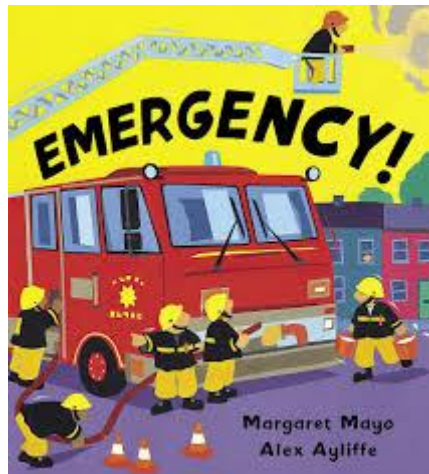


## Ladybird Class home activities



The story for this week is Emergency!

Have a conversation with your child about the different people in the story. Why did they need help? Who did they need help from? Do they know names for the emergency

services? Can they remember some from the story?

Talk to your child (in an appropriate way) about what they should do in an emergency.



Can your child find any vehicles from the story in their toy box or in any of their books?

Can your child hear the sirens of an emergency vehicle outside the house? What do they think the emergency might be?



Can your child make a picture with colours or patterns from the emergency vehicles? Can they make a picture to say thank you to the NHS?

On one of your daily walks, can your child spot an emergency service vehicle? What do they notice? Is it going fast or slow? Is it loud or quiet?
