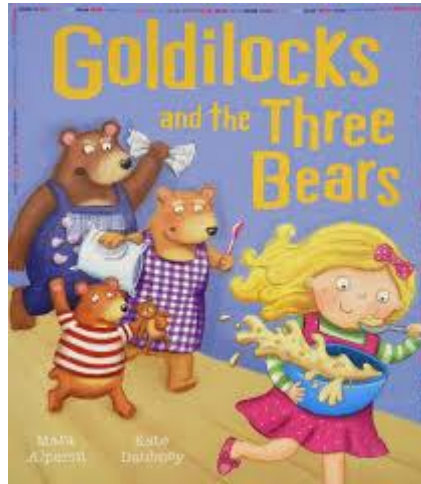


Ladybird Class home activities



The story for this week is *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*.

Can your child remember how the bears, bowls, chairs and beds were described? Can they remember what words like big, medium and little mean? Can you find some things for them to sort into big and little in your house?

Can your child find 3 bowls or plates that are all different sizes? Can they put them in order or say who in your family should eat from each bowl?





Can your child make some big and little food for the bears? You could even make some bear themed food for lunch one day?

Talk with your child about the good and bad choices that Goldilocks made. Was she right to eat porridge that didn't belong to her? What should she have done when she broke the chair?



Can you and your child find out about different bears on the internet or in books at home together? What types of bears are there? What colours are they? Where do they live?
