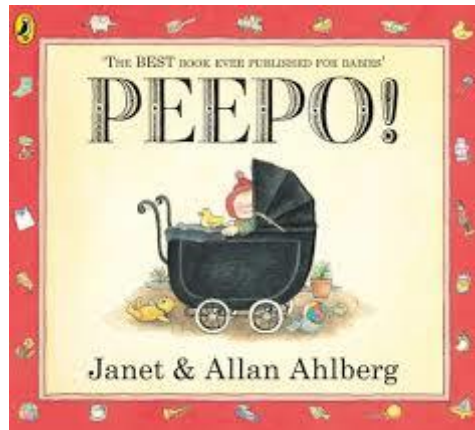


Ladybird Class home activities



The story for this week is Peepo!

What can your child see the next time you read or watch the story? Can they remember some of the parts of the story?



Have a game of Peekaboo with your child. Try covering your face first, either with your hands or a piece of material. Then let your child have a turn. Try pulling funny faces when they look!

Play a game of Kim's game. Use a tray and put 5 random items/small toys on the tray. Let your child look at it and talk about the items. Then cover the tray with a piece of material and take one item away. Can they look and work out what is missing?





Have a game of I Spy. You can use colours instead of initial sounds to help your child guess. I spy with my little eye, something coloured... red. You can use a picture book to help narrow the ideas down.
