

Ladybird Class home activities



The story for this week is The Three Little Pigs

Read the story together if you have the book at home, or you can find it using the following link.

Can your child make 3 houses out of different materials? They could try making a den with material or a duvet, or they could use building blocks, or perhaps even use some paper or a cardboard box. Talk about the textures of the materials; are they rough or smooth, strong or weak?



Can your child find some things around your home that they can blow over? Do an experiment to see if they can find some big and little things they can huff and puff to blow down! You could make it a competition with mummy, daddy or siblings.

Can your child build a tall tower? Remind them to show resilience and to try again if it falls down. Can they think of a better way to do it (maybe a larger base) if it keeps falling down?



Talk to your child about where pigs really live. Do they really live in houses? Show them a picture of where pigs can live. Have they ever seen a pig at a farm before?

If you have any paper plates, or even some paper you can cut into circles, can you and your child make the character masks and retell the story together? They might be able to remember and join in with the repeated parts of the story.
