# No Buggies or Mobile Phones in Nursery

Please be reminded buggies are not permitted inside the nursery for safety reasons and no mobile phones in the interest of safeguarding. If you have a buggy, you are able to leave it in our buggy store. This is located on the left hand side of Rothesay Road, through the metal gates.

#### Children's Absence

If your child is absent from nursery for any reason, please would parents telephone the School Office on **01582 726966.** If you do not phone, please expect a phone call from us to see why your child is absent from nursery.

#### **Collection and Drop Off Times**

Parents are reminded that nursery sessions are 8:30am to 11:30am or 12:45pm to 3:45pm.

Please ensure you are on time for the start and end of your child's session as otherwise your child's learning is affected. Registers will close at 8:45 and 1:00, if your child arrives after this time you may have to wait until our language group is finished at 9:00 and 1:15.

#### **Attendance and Lateness**

It is very important that your child/children attend every day, unless they are too sick to attend.

Please arrive on time, we have noticed a lot of children are arriving at school late and missing out on their learning.

# **Funding for Working Parents**

If your child is 3 and you think you would qualify for 30 hours childcare and education and would like your child to access additional hours in September, you will need to apply by the end of July at the latest.

If you are a working parent of a 2 year old you might be eligible to access 15 hours childcare support.
