Bylaw Amendment:

The Michigan DEQ is now requiring proof of Association Members authorization for lake treatment. Language in our current By Laws is not sufficient to show that Membership has authorized treatment of the lake on an ongoing basis. As a result, your Association Board is recommending the following changes to Article 5 Section 5 of our By Laws. This amendment should allow for the ongoing treatment of the lake without the need for individual authorization each year. Property owners that do not want their lake fronts treated may still contact the Lake Maintenance and Improvement Committee to avoid treatment.
