Day Visitor Policy

This is a temporary policy.

Valid from 01 September 2023 until 01 December 2023

After the 3 months testing period an evaluation will take place and a final decision will be made

Objective of the policy:

To give owners the opportunity to invite friends and family members at their private home at a discounted gate fee

In order to achieve these objectives, the following is applicable:

- A day visitor pays Zar 50
- A day visitor will receive a day visitor card which has to be handed in the same day before midnight.
- The day visitor pass is NOT applicable for building companies and everyone else who will be visiting for purposes of maintenance, repairs etc. Misuse of this pass will lead to penalties.
- The reserve manager personally (not the gate mobile) will be informed about the visitor at least 24 hours prior to the visit.
- The owner will have to confirm the visit of the day visitor and by confirming he/she will agree to this policy
- The following information will be shared; name(s) of the visitor(s), approx arrival time and confirmation of the owner of the plot
- A day visitor is allowed to stay one day, and will have to leave the reserve before midnight
- When a day visitor stays longer than a day (leaves after midnight), a full day gate fee of Zar 150 for the next day will be charged upon departure.
- Day visitors will take a direct route from the gate to the owners house and upon departure will also take the shortest route to the gate. Day visitors are not allowed to do safaris in the reserve.
- Day visitors are only allowed in the private property of the owner who grants them permission
- Day visitors are not allowed to bring pets
- The NGA constitution and all rules and regulations are applicable to this policy and rules will be applied strictly and consistently
- When one abuses these rules, a direct penalty will be handed out to the respective owner and this owner will no longer be able to use the discounted gate fee for day visitors

The following procedure will be applicable

1	Inform the reserve manager personally. The following information is required at least 24 hours prior to the visit <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Name of visitor• Approx time of arrival• Approval of the owner of the plot	
2	The day visitor will receive a day-pass which need to be visible at all times behind the car window	
3	The day visitor will take the shortest route to the home of the owner	
4	The day visitor will only visit the private property of the owner and is not allowed to drive over the reserve	
5	The day visitor needs to leave the reserve before midnight and return the day-pass	
6	When the owner accepts the visit of the day visitor, he/she also accepts the fine of ZAR 150 charged to his/hers account when the day visitor does not hand in the day pass on the same day.
