**Day Visitor Policy as Ratified  
by members of the NGA at AGM of 10 May 2025**

**Objective of the policy:**

To give owners the opportunity to invite friends and family members at a discounted gate fee for a day visit.

**In order to achieve these objectives, the following is applicable:**

- A day visitor fee shall be determined at the Annual General Meeting in line with all other fees.
- The fee shall be a reduced entrance fee.
- A day visitor will receive a day visitor card which has to be handed in the same day before midnight.
- The day visitor pass is NOT applicable for building companies and anyone else who will be visiting for purposes of maintenance, repairs etc. Misuse of this pass will lead to penalties.
- The reserve manager must be informed about the visitor prior to the visit.
- The owner will have to confirm the visit of the day visitor and by confirming the owner will agree to this policy.
- The following information will be shared; name(s) of the visitor(s) and confirmation of the owner of the plot.
- The NGA constitution and all rules and regulations are applicable to this policy and rules will be applied strictly and consistently.
- When one abuses these rules, a direct penalty will be handed out to the respective owner.
- The owner takes full responsibility for the actions of their visitor.
- A day visitor is allowed to stay one day, and will have to leave the reserve before midnight.
- When a day visitor stays longer than a day (leaves after midnight), the top up fee for the general entrance shall be charged on departure.
- Day visitors will take a direct route from the gate to the owner's house and upon departure will also take the shortest route to the gate.
- Day visitors are not allowed to do safaris in the reserve without the presence of the owner
