

Pre- Procedure Information

Please read the instructions below to any Micro pigmentation procedure.

All Micro-pigmentation procedures are multi- appointment procedures

You are required to come back between 6 weeks to 3 months for your second application before it can be determined that your procedure is complete.

Permanent make-up is not a science but an art, and an adjustment of colour or shape is usually required.

When your procedure is complete the colour will be quite intense and dark. It will take 3-5 days for this colour to settle and heal into the skin allowing the soft and natural colour to emerge.

- The area treated will become inflamed and reddened, so it is advised to not make any social engagements for the days following the treatment.
- With cosmetic make-up, on the day of the procedure please wear normal make-up and bring relative eye- brow pencils for colour matching.
- Any form of hair removal, bleaching or tinting should be performed at least 48 hrs pre procedure or 2 weeks post procedure.
- Pre and post photo's will be taken, this is for our records. The photos will not be published without prior consent from the client.
- Sensitivity of the application is greatly increased for female clients that are pre-menstrual.
- Please refrain from the use of alcohol, blood-thinning meds eg. aspirin, Arnica, pain medication, anti-inflammatory, caffeine, diuretics or recreational drugs 24 hours before the procedure. If you have taken any of the mentioned meds, please let us know before the procedure, it does not necessarily mean that we cannot go ahead. We do use a topical anaesthetic to substantially reduce discomfort.
- **IMPORTANT: NO** prescribed medication should be discontinued without permission from your doctor, if you are not sure if your medication will affect the procedure, please contact your therapist before the day!
- A patch test for the pigment is available, free of charge, upon request 24 hrs prior to the procedure.
- Due to strict hygiene regulations, we discourage clients to bring along friends to sit in on the procedures. If you feel it is necessary, it must be pre arranged with your therapist so they are prepared to wear the relevant protective gear.
- Friends are however more than welcome to wait for you in the waiting room.
- Generally, procedures last an hour and a half.
- Please be considerate. If you cannot make your appointment for whatever reason or you are running late, let us know as soon as possible.
