In addition to implementing impactful water projects abroad, Bridge H2OPE supports and oversees it's chapters nationwide—empowering young leaders and fostering nationwide engagement in the fight against water inaccessibility.

2024 PROJECTS COMPLETED:

Clean Water Wells Initiative: Constructed 7 water wells across 4 regions of Ethiopia, providing clean water to over 1,700 individuals.

Portable Water filters: Distributed over 50 water filters installed in over 50 households for safe drinking water leading up to Bridge H2OPE establishment..

WASH Committee Members Trained: Each Bridge H2OPE sponsored water well project has five to ten committee members, equally consisting of men and women. Members were trained to take care of basic hygiene practices at each project site while the government jointly oversaw all completed projects.


