Lavender will try to get one of the Divide volunteer firemen to come and also ask the Teller County Sheriff to come and talk about a wildfire safety exit strategy for Sherwood Forest residents. We will also host a chili lunch fundraiser afterward with a raffle event. Billie will organize and lead the efforts. All agreed to help.
