Help Protect Your Home and Community from Wildfires!

Here are some quick tips.

- Regularly clean your roof and gutters.
- Inspect your chimney twice a year and clean at least once a year.
- Use 1/8th inch mesh screen beneath porches, decks or any open areas underneath your home and don't forget openings to roof or attic.
- Create a 30 100 feet safety zone around your home. Rake up leaves, dead limbs and twigs and also remove them from under structures.
- Remove limbs from trees up to 15 feet from ground or from 1/3rd the height of smaller trees. If possible, thin trees growing to 15 feet space between tree crowns.
- Finally, watch for Teller County Burn Bans, honor their restrictions and report any potential fire to Teller Sheriff at 719-687-9652 OR 911 if in immediate danger.

The SFIA has many wildfire preparations pamphlets available. Come to our meeting and get some!
