Are you ready for the new decade?!?! 2020 is going to be a great year here in the forest!

But, before we get to 2020, here are a few of the highlights from the second half of 2019.

SFIA Properties At our July 2019 semi-annual meeting, the SFIA discussed the need for additional financial sources for our general fund, and it was agreed by the members present that we consider offering two of our smaller properties (less than .25 aces) for purchase by current adjacent property owners. After mailing ballots to members who are current on their dues, the results on 10.22.19 resulted that the SFIA had permission from a majority to accomplish this goal. We are now in the offer process and will update the sale status at our January semi-annual meeting.

New Board Members We are so pleased to have added two more wonderful volunteers to our board, David Robertson and Dan Crown. This helps meets our requirement to have at least 5 members at large. Jean Miller is also interested in serving on the board. We hope to have them all at our January 26th semi-annual meeting, 1:00 pm at the Pikes Peak Community Center so that you can meet them personally.
