RECIPE OF THE QUARTER

DIRECTIONS

In a large sauce pan, melt butter over moderately low heat. Add scallion bulbs, bell pepper, and celery and cook, stirring occasionally, until vegetables start to soften, about 10 minutes. Stir in potatoes, 2 cups corn, bay leaf, broth, and salt. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer, stirring occasionally, for 15 minutes. In a blender or food processor, puree remaining 2 cups corn with milk. Stir puree into soup along with black pepper. Simmer until soup thickens slightly 5 to 10 minutes, remove bay leaf. Stir in scallion greens. Top off each serving with a dollop of sour cream.

Ingredients:

2 tablespoons butter
4 scallions, greens & whites
1 red bell pepper, chopped
2 ribs celery, chopped
1-pound potatoes peeled and
cut into ½" cubes (about 3)
4 cups of fresh corn kernels
1 bay leaf
1 quart chicken broth
2 cups milk
2 teaspoons of salt
½ teaspoon of pepper
