



Solid Douglas Fir Mixed Grain



Species Color & Tone: Solid Mixed Grain Douglas Fir has a warmer, more saturated palette, from light yellow and honey to richer reddish browns. Strong contrast between earlywood and latewood produces a subtle striping that immediately reads as Northwest timber. Left near natural, it feels warm and familiar, but it can be deepened with stain when you want a more dramatic feature ceiling.

Grain & Appearance: Mixed Grain Fir combines broad cathedrals with sections of straighter grain, giving a refined yet expressive surface. The ring pattern reinforces linear ceiling systems and adds depth under grazing light, which suits hospitality, cultural, and branded environments where the wood is meant to be noticed.
