



Solid Western Hemlock Mixed Grain



Species Color & Tone: Mixed Grain Western Hemlock is a light, neutral softwood that sits between blond and warmer tan woods. Color runs from pale straw to soft beige with subtle golden undertones, and sapwood and heartwood stay close in value so the ceiling reads as one quiet field. It is receptive to transparent and custom stains, which lets you push it cooler, warmer, or darker without losing its soft character.

Grain & Appearance: Mixed grain shows a blend of straight grain and gentle cathedrals, creating measured movement rather than strong figure. The surface feels natural and authentic but not rustic, so it works for linear plank systems and larger tiles in lobbies, classrooms, and open office ceilings.
