



Cherry Plain Sliced Veneer



Species Color & Tone: Cherry Plain Sliced Veneer starts as a warm pink tan and gradually matures into richer red brown, which gives ceilings a sense of age and permanence. Color variation from sheet to sheet is noticeable but still refined, and stain can nudge it brown-er or more neutral while keeping the underlying warmth. It is a practical way to introduce a classic, premium feel without moving into the darkest species.

Grain & Appearance: Plain sliced Cherry shows cathedral grain through the center of the flitch with straighter grain at the edges. Fine texture, small gum streaks, and occasional pin knots lend a crafted, “library” character that suits formal or semi formal interiors.
