



## Douglas Fir Quarter Sliced Veneer



**Species Color & Tone:** Douglas Fir Quarter Sliced Veneer offers light yellow, cream, and warm reddish brown tones that read as distinctly timber based. The contrast between earlywood and latewood is present but moderated by the quarter cut, so the color banding feels ordered rather than rustic. Designers often keep it near natural to retain a Northwest sensibility, with subtle stain adjustments for coordination.

**Grain & Appearance:** Quarter slicing yields fine, straight pinstripes with very few cathedrals, producing a strong sense of direction across panels. This controlled grain supports long baffles, slatted ceilings, and corridor runs where you want warmth, rhythm, and clarity without visual clutter.
