Species Color & Tone: Sapele Quarter Sliced Veneer begins pinkish and matures into deep red brown or purple brown, giving ceilings a rich, saturated presence. It is often selected as a more economical route to a luxurious mahogany like look, especially in theaters, hotels, and high visibility public spaces where the wood needs to stand out. Clear and lightly toned finishes show its depth best.

Grain & Appearance: Quartered Sapele is defined by its ribbon stripe figure, alternating light and dark bands that gently shimmer with movement and grazing light. The satiny texture responds well to careful finishing, creating feature walls and ceilings that feel animated but still controlled.
