



Walnut Quarter Sliced Veneer



Species Color & Tone: Walnut Quarter Sliced Veneer keeps the deep, desirable browns of Walnut while tightening the overall read. Tones typically fall from medium chocolate to darker espresso and mellow slightly with time, but dramatic sapwood streaks are reduced compared with plain sliced. This makes it easier to maintain a consistent dark field in large ceilings or wall runs.

Grain & Appearance: Quartering produces straight, fine striping with very limited cathedral figure, so the grain feels tailored and disciplined. From a distance, fields appear calm and uniform, while close views reveal subtle line work, fitting contemporary, minimalist, and executive interiors that rely on restraint.
