



White Oak Rift Sliced Veneer



Species Color & Tone: White Oak Rift Sliced Veneer offers straw to light wheat tones that sit naturally within minimalist and hospitality palettes. The color range is narrower than plain sliced, so long runs of panels and slats feel more uniform. It stains reliably from light greiges to deeper smoked browns, which helps designers dial in very specific neutral stories on a single species.

Grain & Appearance: Rift slicing produces straight, comb like grain and intentionally avoids heavy flake figure. The result is a vertical texture that reads contemporary and tailored, especially in linear plank and grille systems where the grain direction and product geometry reinforce each other.
