



Solid Western Hemlock Vertical Grain (VG)



Species Color & Tone: Vertical Grain Western Hemlock is one of the palest options, with straw to light beige color and very little contrast board to board. The tone feels quiet and neutral, which lets other finishes and lighting do the visual heavy lifting. It is an excellent base for transparent or slightly toned stains when you want a calm ceiling that leans Scandinavian or Japanese in spirit.

Grain & Appearance: Vertical grain cutting produces tight, straight lines with minimal pin knots and almost no cathedrals. The result is a stable, orderly field that supports crisp reveals, grille systems, and long continuous runs without distracting pattern shifts, ideal for galleries, focused workspaces, and restrained hospitality interiors.
