

COVID Updates

We take no pleasure in having to headline our newsletter with a subject we have all grown rather weary of, but alas, that's where we are at (still!). In no particular order, here are a number of updates to be aware of:

- 1) KBYH staff continue to work from home for the most part, but someone is at the office everyday. We have not set a return-to-work date as of yet. If you need to come to the office, please make arrangements ahead of time and plan to use CDC precautions while on the premises.
- 2) In person visitations (foster children with their biological family) are starting to resume. All parties are expected to adhere to CDC guidelines (that should be explained by a social worker prior to the commencement of an in-person visit). Please be sure to consult with a social worker prior to a visit to be sure you understand the expectations and to express any concerns or reservations you may have.
- 3) KBYH's annual FFA summer camp has been cancelled. If conditions allow, we may hold a one-day camp sometime in August.
- 4) Camp Forever (KBYH's adoption family camp) is tentatively scheduled for 8/28-8/30. There is a small chance a minimized version of this camp will be offered, but that remains to be determined.
- 5) The KBYH Resource Parent and volunteer appreciation dinner has been tentatively rescheduled for September. More details to come at a later date.
- 6) KBYH has PPE supplies available for staff as well as Resource Parents. Anyone in need of PPE supplies, please feel free to reach out to any KBYH staff member.
- 7) Per the governor's directives on 6/18/20, face coverings are generally expected when outside of the home. We ask that all KBYH staff as well as resource parents abide by this expectation.
