### Ephesians 3:7-8

<sup>7</sup> of which I became a **minister according to the gift of the grace** of God given to me by the **effective working of His power**.

### PURPOSE OF THE MYSTERY

<sup>8</sup>To me, who am **less than the least of all the saints**, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ.

## LET NO CORRUPT COMMUNICATION

### Ephesians 4:29

<sup>29</sup> Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

## WHAT DOES GOD SAY ABOUT PROFANITY?

Paul warns us in Ephesians 4:29: “**Do** not let any unwholesome (filthy) **talk** come from your mouth, but only what is **good for building someone up** in need.” Then he **says** in Ephesians 5:4 “Nor should there be any obscenity, foolish **talk** or crude joking, which are out of place.”

## POWER OF THE TONGUE

### Proverbs 18:21

Death and life *are* in the **power of the tongue**, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

## YOU ALSO WERE WITH JESUS OF GALILEE

### Matthew 26:69-71

<sup>69</sup> Now Peter sat outside in the courtyard. And a servant girl came to him, saying, “You also were with Jesus of Galilee.”

<sup>70</sup> But he denied it before *them* all, saying, “I do not know what you are saying.”

## HE DENIED WITH AN OATH

### Matthew 26:71-74

<sup>1</sup> And when he had gone out to the gateway, another *girl* saw him and said to those *who were* there, “This *fellow* also was with Jesus of Nazareth.”

<sup>72</sup> But again he denied with an oath, “I do not know the Man!”

<sup>73</sup> And a little later those who stood by came up and said to Peter, “Surely you also are *one* of them, for your speech betrays you.”

<sup>74</sup> Then he began to curse and swear, *saying*, “I do not know the Man!”

## **DO NOT LOSE HEART AT MY TRIBULATIONS**

### **Ephesians 3:9-13**

<sup>9</sup> and to make all see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ; <sup>10</sup> to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly *places*, <sup>11</sup> according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, <sup>12</sup> in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him. <sup>13</sup> Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.

### **Ephesians 3:14-17**

<sup>14</sup> For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>15</sup> from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, <sup>16</sup> that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup> that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love.

## BE FILLED WITH ALL THE FULLNESS OF GOD

### Ephesians 3:18-21

<sup>18</sup> may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height— <sup>19</sup> to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you **may be filled with all the fullness of God.**

<sup>20</sup> Now to Him who is **able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask** or think, according to the power that works in us, <sup>21</sup> to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.
