One of the most powerful analogies in the Bible regarding our transformation and sanctification in the Lord has to be the analogy of the potter and the clay. The Bible says that **God is the Potter** and we are the clay.

It is up to God to **mold, transform, and sanctify** us as we journey through this earthly life.

Whenever God gives us a specific analogy in the Bible, this means that we have to seek into the revelation of that analogy in order to pick up what He is trying to tell us with the analogy. If we do, then we will see exactly what God is trying to tell us

Proud heart *is* an abomination

Proverbs 16:5

Everyone proud in heart *is* an abomination to the LORD; *though they join* forces, none will go unpunished.

Psalm 51:10-19 (KJV)

¹⁰Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

¹¹Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.

¹²Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit.

¹³**Then will I teach transgressors thy ways**; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.

Let patience have her perfect work

James 1:4-5 (KJV)

⁴ But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, **wanting nothing**.

⁵ If any of you **lack wisdom**, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraided not; and it shall be given him.

Faith nothing wavering

James 1:5-6 (KJV)

⁶ But let him ask in **faith**, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

⁷ For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

⁸ A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

Mold

Transform Romans 12:2 (KJV)

² And be not **conformed to this world**: but be ye **transformed** by the **renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what is that **good**, and **acceptable**, and **perfect**, will of God.

Sanctify Means to: Set apart', in the sense of being set apart from all else and dedicated for Yahweh **God's** use.
