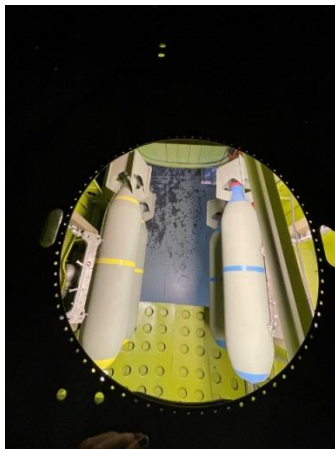
## Breakfast Club

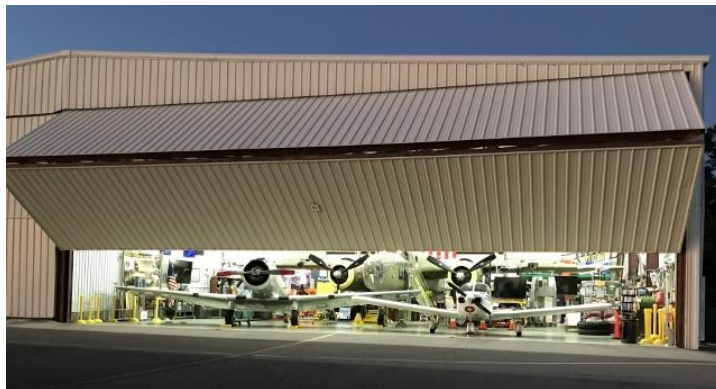


## Random Pictures of GF2
