SUMMER MUSIC CAMP SCHOLARSHIP AUDITIONS 2025



The 2025 Scholarship Auditions for summer music programs, sponsored by The Port Huron Musicale, will be conducted **Friday, March 7, 2025, at 4:00 PM at the Pilgrim Lutheran Church, 1023 Michigan Avenue, Marysville, MI.** Students eligible to apply are those who are currently enrolled in grades 9 through 11, and who are residents of the Port Huron or Marysville Schools Districts <u>or</u> whose teachers are members of The Port Huron Musicale. Previous winners are not eligible to audition.

Auditions are open to students of piano, voice, organ, and band and orchestra instruments. Please note that these are open auditions before an audience. Students may audition on more than one instrument or voice by submitting additional forms and fees.

Pieces performed must meet the following criteria:

- The two selections must be from *contrasting musical periods, composers, and styles.*
- Memorization is not required.
- Performance time is not to exceed ten minutes.
- Students must provide judges with one original score of their music. Photocopies are not allowed unless permission has been given by the publisher. Downloaded music must show proof of ownership.
- Applicants are required to provide an accompanist if the piece is written to be performed with an accompanist.

The application and entry fee must be received by <u>February 21, 2025</u>. The \$10 non-refundable entry fee must be sent by check or money order, payable to The Port Huron Musicale. Cash is not accepted.

Applicants will perform before a judge; the judge's decision is final. The \$1,000 scholarship is for a summer music camp of the applicant's choice, subject to approval of the scholarship committee. The scholarship winner will be expected to perform for a program of The Port Huron Musicale in March 2026. The winner will not be announced at the conclusion of the audition. A letter will be sent to each applicant within two weeks of the audition indicating if a scholarship has been awarded.
