SHED GUIDELINES

STORAGE BUILDINGS WHICH ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF OR CONTIGUOUS WITH THE ARCHITECTURE

OF THE HOME, MAY BE PERMITTED, SUBJECT TO HERITAGE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION APPROVAL, AND

MUST BE LANDSCAPED SO THEY ARE ADEQUATELY SHIELDED FROM, AND NOT INFRINGE ON THE

NEIGHBOR'S VISIBILITY.

FREESTANDING ACCESSORY STRUCTURES SUCH AS, SHEDS AND PLAY HOUSES MUST BE LOCATED IN
REAR YARDS AND APPROVED BY THE HERITAGE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION. THE DESIGN AND DETAIL
OF THE STRUCTURE MUST BE CONSISTENT WITH THE RESIDENCE, AND MUST BE OTHERWISE
ACCEPTABLE TO THE HERITAGE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION IN ALL RESPECTS. NO OPEN STORAGE OF ANY
KIND IS PERMITTED.

THE RESIDENT SHALL BE REPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ANY, AND ALL, LOCAL AND COUNTY PERMITS.
