




LIGHTEN UP MEALS WITH A SAVORY SALAD

Some occasions call for a light dish, and such occasions tend be more common in warm weather. Gone are the days of heavy, stick-to-your-ribs meals, and in their places are fresh, light and easy meals.

Salad is more than just lettuce and other greens, and that's notable in this recipe for "Salmon, Asparagus and Orzo" Salad courtesy of "Cooking Light Dinner's Ready" (Oxmoor House) by the Cooking Light Kitchens.

Salmon, Asparagus and Orzo Salad 6 servings

- 6 cups water
- 1 pound asparagus, trimmed and cut into 3-inch pieces
- 1 cup uncooked orzo
- 1 (1 1/4-pound) skinless salmon fillet
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
 - Cooking spray
- 1/4 cup thinly sliced red onion
 - 1. Preheat broiler.
- 2. Bring water to a boil in a large saucepan. Add asparagus; cook 3 minutes, or until crisp-tender. Remove asparagus from water with tongs or a slotted spoon, reserving water in a pan. Plunge asparagus into ice water; drain the ice water and set asparagus aside.
 - 3. Return reserved water to a boil. Add orzo, and cook according to package directions, omitting salt and fat.
- 4. While orzo cooks, sprinkle fillet evenly with salt and pepper. Place fish on a foil-lined broiler pan coated with cooking spray. Broil 5 minutes, or until desired degree of doneness. Using 2 forks, break fish into large chunks. Combine fish, orzo, asparagus, and onion.

Explaining Clinical Trials

Over the last several decades, survival rates for many types of cancers have improved dramatically. Much of that improvement can be traced to the tireless efforts of cancer researchers and the organizations and donors who fund their research.

According to the National Institutes of Health, there are two types of clinical research: observational studies and clinical trials. Observational studies observe people in normal settings, and during these studies, researchers gather information, group volunteers according to broad characteristics and compare changes over time. Observational studies sometimes help researchers discover new opportunities for clinical trials, which are research studies that aim to evaluate medical, surgical or behavioral interventions. Clinical studies are often how researchers learn if new drugs and treatments are safe and effective.

Clinical trials are somewhat routine, though they tend to capture the attention of the general public during public health crises. For example, much attention was paid to clinical trials during the recent COVID-19 outbreak as researchers hurried to develop a vaccine for the novel coronavirus.

Cancer researchers utilize clinical trials to advance treatments and as part of ongoing efforts to find a cure for all types of cancer. In the United States, these trials must go through various phases as outlined by the Federal Drug Administration. During these phases, treatments are tested and researchers try to find appropriate dosages while also documenting any potential side effects. A clinical trial must go through three phases before a drug can be approved for use.

- Phase I: A phase I clinical trial tests an experimental treatment on a small group of people, typically healthy people between the ages of 20 and 80. Phase I aims to judge the safety of a treatment and find any side effects while also determining dosage.
- Phase II: More people are typically needed for a phase II clinical trial, which may require as many as 300 participants. The NIH notes that a goal of phase II trials is to obtain data regarding the effectiveness of the drug on people who have certain diseases or conditions. Safety, particularly in regard to short-term side effects, also is studied during a phase II trial, which can last for several years.
- Phase III: Different populations and different dosages are studied during phase III trials, which may require the participation of several hundred, if not thousands, of people. Positive results during a phase III trial typically result in FDA approval.

Once a drug is approved by the FDA, a phase IV trial is conducted to study the effectiveness and safety among large, diverse populations. The NIH notes that the side effects of a drug may not become clear until more people are studied over very long periods of time, which is why drugs are often studied even after they're approved by the FDA.

THIS COUNTRY FAVORITE MAKES THE PERFECT SIDE DISH

"Country cooking" has different connotations depending on where one might be in the world. Many people attest that country cooking involves comfort cuisine foods that originated in the southeastern United States. Quite often such cuisine includes biscuits, gravy, fried chicken, boiled greens, and other delicious items made from simple ingredients.

Corn muffins can be another staple of country cooking. Corn meal is a versatile ingredient that is the star of this simple side dish that can be made sweet or savory with just a few substitutions. Check out this lip-smacking version of corn muffins, from "Virgil's Barbecue Road Trip Cookbook" (St. Martin's Press) by Neal Corman.

Lip-Smacking Corn Muffins

Serves 4-6

- 1 1/3 cups yellow cornmeal
- 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup, plus 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon kosher salt
- 3/4 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 cups buttermilk
- 1/2 cup whole milk
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- 1/2 8-ounce bag shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup fresh corn kernels
- 3 tablespoons chopped scallions
- 3 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro
- 1/2 teaspoon hot sauce



- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 F. Butter a muffin tin and dust it with flour.
- 2. Thoroughly combine the first six ingredients in the bowl of a stand mixer or a large mixing bowl, if using a hand mixer. Combine and mix the remaining ingredients in a separate mixing bowl.
- 3. Slowly add the wet mix to the dry, while blending on low speed. Continue blending until entirely incorporated.
- 4. Fill each muffin tin three-quarters full of the batter. Bake for 18 to 20 minutes, or until light golden brown on top.
- 5. Remove the muffin tins from the oven and allow to cool for 15 to 20 minutes. Serve slightly warm.


