The 25th Annual Save Our Waters Week Grand Finale Program

Quinn Zacharias of Alachua County, FL will speak at this year's 25th Annual Save Our Waters Week finale held at the Old Courthouse Heritage Museum, 1 Courthouse Square, Inverness, on Saturday, September 26 from 2-3pm. This event will be offered both live and virtually.

Mr. Zacharias is an Environmental Engineer and Research Assistant at the UF Howard T. Odum Center for Wetlands. His "2020 Vision: Focusing on Florida's Water Issues" presentation will address several hot topics in water resources including: nutrient management, algal blooms, storm water flooding/erosion, spring/groundwater protection and coastline protection. These five issues are pervasive throughout the State of Florida and need diligent attention. Mr. Zacharias will be discussing and sharing the most up to date research on these topics.

Quinn will be graduating this fall with a Bachelor of Sciences degree in environmental engineering with an honor's thesis on phosphorus management in the South Florida Watershed. He intends to start the graduate school program in environmental engineering next spring.

Kick off football season with a tailgating staple

Football is back, and with it comes all of the delicious foods served at parking lot tailgates and viewing parties at home. Perhaps no food is more synonymous with football than chicken wings. Sports bars make names for themselves based on their chicken wings, but football fans need not visit their local pubs to indulge in wings worthy of gameday. The following recipe for "Chicken Wings with Bacon Barbecue Sauce" from John Holl's "The American Craft Beer Cookbook" (Storey) is simple and sure to please foodies and their fellow football fans this season.

Chicken Wings with Bacon Barbecue Sauce

Makes 12 wings and plenty of leftover sauce

- 1 cup roughly chopped applewood-smoked bacon
- 12 large chicken wings
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 1/4 cup diced yellow onion
- 1/4 cup dark brown sugar
- 1 cup New Albanian BobÕs Old 15-B Porter, or similar robust porter
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter
- 2 cups veal or beef broth
- 1/2 cup Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tablespoon puree chipotle in adobo
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme

1/4 teaspoon garlic powder



- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 F. Put the bacon in a heavy skillet and cook it in the oven until crispy. Transfer the bacon to a paper towel-lined plate, reserving the fat in the skillet. Reduce the oven temperate to 350 F and move the skillet to the stovetop.
- 2. Toss the chicken wings in the olive oil, arrange them on a baking sheet and bake for 1 hour, or until crisp and cooked through.
- 3. Add the onion to the bacon fat in the skillet and cook over medium-high heat, stirring occasionally, until golden brown, 5 to 7 minutes. Be careful handling the skillet; it will still be hot from the oven.
- 4. Add the brown sugar to the skillet and cook over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until it dissolves. Add the beer, scraping the bottom of the skillet with a spatula to loosen any brown bits. Stir in the butter and simmer until the liquid is reduced by half, stirring occasionally.
- 5. After the beer has reduced, add the broth to the skillet and reduce until the jam is thick, stirring occasionally and being careful not to burn it, 10 to 20 minutes.
- 6. Add the Worcestershire, chipotle, oregano, thyme, and garlic powder to the skillet and stir to fully incorporate.
- 7. Transfer the sauce and bacon to a blender, let cool for 8 to 10 minutes, and then puree until smooth. Remove the chicken wings from the oven, place them in a large bowl, and pour in enough sauce to liberally coat the chicken. Serve immediately.

Archaeologist, Sean Norman to speak on the Archaeology of the **Battle of Wahoo Swamp**

TECHNOLOGY THAT CAN MAKE DRIVING SAFER



Technology plays such a significant role in modern life that it can sometimes prove hard to ignore, even when drivers are behind the wheel. In fact, data from the National Security Council indicates that more than 700 people are injured in distracted driving crashes every day, and many of those crashes involve drivers who were distracted by their devices.

LED headlights tend to produce greater light output than traditional headlamps, making it easier for drivers to see at night. LED headlights also last much longer than halogen bulbs, meaning they won't fade as quickly, keeping more light on the road for longer periods of time.
- Autonomous cruise control: Autonomous cruise control, or ACC, systems operate in similar fashion to traditional cruise control with a key distinction. When engaged, ACC systems adjust vehicle speeds so cars and trucks maintain a safe distance from vehicles ahead of them.

MMM! SEAFOOD! QUICK AND FILLING MEAL SERVED UP IN A SNAP

After the lazy days of summer, fall often arrives with packed schedules and everyone getting back on track, whether for work or school. Busy families may not have much time to spend in the kitchen these days, but they don't need to devote hours to cooking. Even quick meals can serve up significant flavor.

In the time it takes to boil rice, this recipe for "Creamy Rice With Roasted Shrimp and Tomatoes," courtesy of "Real Simple Dinner Tonight: Done" (Time Home Entertainment) from the editors of Real Simple, can be put on the table. Arborio rice makes this dish creamy, but if it's unavailable, long-grain rice also can be used – just follow the package directions for cooking.

Creamy Rice With Roasted Shrimp and Tomatoes

Serves 4

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 1 cup Arborio rice
- cup dry white wine
 Kosher salt and black pepper
- 1 pound peeled and deveined medium shrimp
- 2 pints grape tomatoes
- 8 sprigs fresh thyme
- 2 cloves garlic



Heat oven to 400 F. Heat 1 tablespoon of the oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add the onion and cook until soft, 5 to 7 minutes. Add the rice and wine and cook, stirring, until the wine is absorbed, 1 to 2 minutes.

Add 2 cups water and 1/4 teaspoon each salt and pepper to the saucepan. Simmer, covered, until the water is absorbed and the rice is tender, 18 to 20 minutes.

Meanwhile, on a rimmed baking sheet, toss the shrimp, tomatoes, thyme, and garlic with the remaining tablespoon of oil and 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper. Roast until the shrimp are opaque throughout, 15 to 20 minutes. Serve over the rice.




