



What Fits Inside Your Eco-Tote?

Our totes are the "Goldilocks" size of moving—large enough to hold your essentials, but designed so they don't become too heavy to carry once full

The "Room-by-Room" Visualizer

- The Bedroom: 1 king-size comforter OR 15–20 pairs of jeans OR roughly 30–40 folded T-shirts.
- The Kitchen: A standard 12-piece dinnerware set (plates, bowls, mugs) plus your silverware drawer and a few small appliances like a toaster or hand mixer.
- The Bathroom: 12–15 plush bath towels OR every single item in your medicine cabinet and under-sink storage combined.
- The Office: About 20–25 large hardcover books OR two full "bankers' box" loads of paperwork.
- The Closet: 12–15 pairs of shoes (depending on the size/bulk) OR your entire handbag collection.

Packing Pro-Tips

The 50lb Rule: Because these totes are sturdy, it's easy to overpack them! We recommend filling the bottom with heavy items (books/plates) and the top with lighter items (pillows/linens) to keep the weight manageable.

The Perfect Fit: Our totes are 11.8 inches deep, meaning most standard-sized vinyl records, large coffee table books, and 12-inch frying pans can lay flat or stand upright perfectly.
