A group of 5 students chosen out of 140 auditionees for their playing proficiency. This group spent several days recording and performing for the commercial, due to air nationally in 2023.

Pacific Crest Drum and Bugle Corps

Southern California's only World Class drum corps. Members of this program travel and perform 22 shows nationally over the course of 8 weeks between mid-June to mid-August, competing in 12 states at prestigious locations including, but not limited to, the Alamo Dome in San Antonio, Texas, the Rose Bowl in Pasadena, California, J. Birney Crum Stadium in Allentown, Pennsylvania, and Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis, Indiana. Pacific Crest performed in DCI's preliminary and semifinals performances this season, ending with a score of 80.25. Staff that worked with the corps include Nathan Pratt, Matt Collins, Sean Phelan, DJ Landoll, Darren Loney, Anthony Clark, Andrew Fresquez, Kira Pattinson, Trevor Stojanovich, and other distinguished members of the Drum Corps International organization.
